

Swedish development co-operation as regards cultural heritage

CHwB and Sida (Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency) arranged a seminar on November 23th 2000 on the theme of Swedish development co-operation as regards Cultural Heritage. The purpose was to gain an overall picture of Swedish aid for cultural heritage, to utilise the experiences from projects already terminated and to discuss aid for cultural heritage as an integral part of the Swedish aid programmes. An additional aim was to initiate discussions in preparation for a larger international seminar on aid for cultural heritage.
